Parade Information:

- The 48th Annual Sutter Buttes Day Parade will kick off promptly at 10:00 a.m.
- Participants will meet behind South Butte Market (corner of Walnut Avenue & South Butte Road in Sutter) beginning at 9:20 a.m. for check-in. Please arrive no later than 9:40 a.m. to ensure you are placed in the correct lineup order.
- Parking is available along Walnut Street and at Sutter High School. Kindly do not park in the market parking lot.
- This year's theme is Celebrating 250 Years of the United States of America – we can't wait to see your patriotic spirit on display!

Cardboard Boat Race Information:

- Boats and oars must be made only of cardboard, duct tape, and recycled plastic (2-liter bottles or milk jugs).
- No other materials are allowed.
- Children who are not sufficiently skilled swimmers must wear a life jacket.
- Participants may race solo or as a team.
- Racers will get in their boats and paddle across the pool to the finish line.
- No entry fee.
- Age Groups: Up to 5 years old, 6–8 years old, & 9–12 years old
- Please be at the west-side pool fence (near the gazebo) with your boat ready by 10:30 a.m. Races will begin shortly after the parade concludes.

Vendor Information:

Commercial Booth Fee: \$25 (non-refundable). In addition to the booth fee, all vendors are asked to donate a gift basket valued at least \$25 for the Sutter Buttes Day raffle. Proceeds from the raffle and event support the Sutter Youth Organization and help fund our community events throughout the year.

Non-Vendor/Community Outreach Booths are free.

- Booth spaces are approximately 10' x 10' and must be fully set up and operational from 11:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. You may begin setting up at 8:00 a.m., but booths must not close before 3:30 p.m.
- All booth operators are responsible for:
 - Setting up and taking down their booth
 - Providing a clearly marked sign identifying their booth
 - Bringing their own tables, chairs, and shade structure (strongly recommended due to potential warm weather)
 - Bring a 100 ft. extension cord and any necessary splitters if electricity is needed
 - Providing their own hoses for water booths
 - Cleaning up their booth space at the end of the event
- To protect the park's sprinkler system, please do not park or drive on the lawn during setup or clean-up.
